Crisis Nursery to build fifth area location

The **Saint Louis Crisis Nursery** will break ground next week on its fifth regional location, a \$500,000, 2,900-square-foot building on the grounds of SSM St. Joseph Health Center-Wentzville, according to a Crisis Nursery spokeswoman.

The Community & Children's Resource Board of St. Charles County (CCRB), **T.R. Hughes** and **SSM Health Care** are making the expansion possible with SSM providing space for the construction and CCRB and T.R. Hughes covering the cost of the project. This fifth Crisis Nursery site will care for as many as 10 children at a time.

TRH Commercial Group LLC is the project's general contractor. The Wentzville location is scheduled to open in April and will have 8 employees.

The Saint Louis Crisis Nursery is a non-profit organization dedicated to the prevention of child abuse and neglect. It is a temporary safe haven for children, from birth through age 12, whose families are experiencing crisis.
